With a thoughtful layout and homely touches throughout, Kathleen feels spacious, warm, and wonderfully functional.

Located at the stern, the dedicated desk area is perfect for those working remotely or needing a creative corner.

The bedroom is surprisingly large and filled with natural light from multiple windows. A full-sized bed takes centre stage, surrounded by ample under-bed and overhead storage. Two radiators ensure the space remains warm and cosy year-round. Sliding doors offer privacy while maintaining an open feel through to the rest of the boat.

Walking through to the bathroom, you'll find a stylish, modern space that wouldn't be out of place in a home. A full-size corner shower with glass doors and a rainfall showerhead offers comfort and convenience. There's a pump-out toilet, a ceramic basin with integrated storage, and a heated towel rail, all enhanced by grey-toned tiles and quality fittings. The walk-through layout allows for easy movement between the bedroom and living areas.

The galley is beautifully finished with pale worktops, light blue tiled splashbacks, and oak cabinetry. It's fitted with everything you need to cook and dine onboard: a gas hob, oven, microwave, fridge, and plentiful preparation space. Open shelving adds character and functionality, while under-cabinet drawers provide excellent storage. A wide work surface also serves as a casual breakfast bar or serving area.

The open-plan saloon is both inviting and versatile. An L-shaped built-in dinette provides relaxed seating and easily converts into a comfortable double bed, increasing the boat's berths to four. Large windows along both sides fill the space with natural light, while radiator heating keeps it warm and welcoming. The forward-facing position offers lovely views out over the bow, enhancing the connection with your surroundings.
